



## Assembly Plan – Sustainability

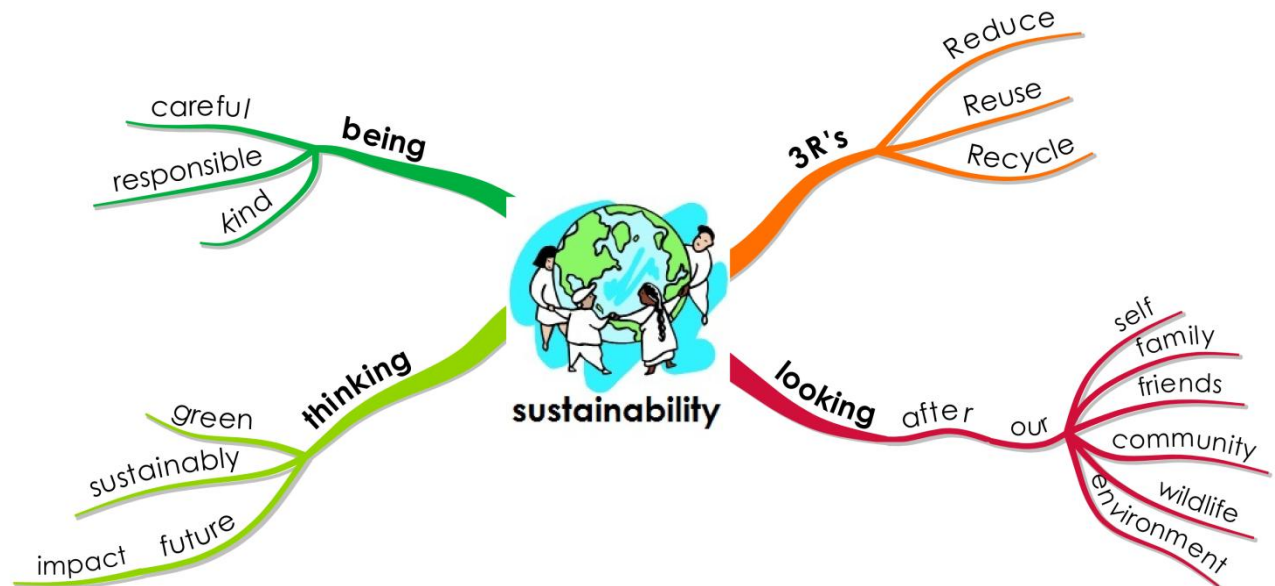
Theme: Sustainability – Taking Action

Prop: A pair of white glasses with two green lenses (like 3D specs)

### Before Assembly

Put on whiteboard, (or on wall) words that describe sustainability, for example:



### During Assembly

Ask children for their top 'sustainability' tips for home and school  
i.e.

- Use both sides of a piece of paper before recycling.
- Avoid products that are packaged for single use (i.e., drinks, school lunches, sweets)

Group tips under the headings "Reduce, Reuse and Recycle" with discussion. (Either on white board or on large sheets of paper)

Talk about impact to environment if everyone followed the tips under each group.

Collectively order the headings Reduce, Reuse and Recycle in order of impact to our world.

Decide which one of these headings the school collectively want to work towards.

Explain that **after assembly** you will:

- take all of the tips under the winning heading put each tip at the top of a sheet of A4 paper
- put where all children can access during break/lunch time

Then ask that each child sign their name on at least one of these sheets to confirm that they will 'pledge' to follow this tip/s over the next week.

Follow up on progress in **future assembly**.
